- 7. Attend at least one School of Instruction
- 8. Bring a prospective member to at least one activity.
- 9. Attend at least one Official Visit of another Bethel.
- 10. Participate in forming the cross for at least one event other than a Bethel meeting.

When new members become quickly involved and active in their Bethels, they become our best prospects for remaining active and generating new potential members.
